I am Rintu Mardy, working as Area Manager in the SOMPRITY Project of SIL Bangladesh in the Naogaon area. We are working here with the Mahle and Oraon minority language community people. I was a bit disoriented when I came to

this area. This was the first time I had come to stay in a new area with the new communities away from my own locality. I was hesitant about the different people, language and culture. But, being from an indigenous people myself, I do not have to face any challenges in working with them. When I started my work here, there were Covid-19 outbreaks in the whole country. I was fortunate that, in my working area the rate of it Covid infection was quite slow. The people of our Indige-



nous community are very friendly and hospitable. But, because of the Covid-19 situation, they were facing challenges due to imposing various rules and re-



strictions of free movement! I tried to visit every single village to make them aware of the benefits of these imposed rules and restrictions. Now. they have become aware in Covid, the need for limitation of free movement and

sues such as like; avoiding gathering of people, daily shopping, visiting local shops and relatives etc.
