The Kol community has been living in the border area of Rajshai-Chapainowabgonj District located in Godagari Upazila's 3no. Mohonpur Union for a very long time. Because of the situation, types of the soil and the low water level, the communication system is undeveloped as it is quite an isolated area. The barren fields and low hills were used for grazing. Without rain, cultivation of crops was not an option. The Kol community was living without the benefit of education and health facilities as there were no governmentsupported institutions in the area.

To enhance their lives, SIL Bangladesh started another project in 2015 on multilingual education (MLE), adult literacy, Learning Circle, Generation Next Groups (GNG), awareness raising, choosing alternative professions, health education, and a livelihood program along with Child Rights and Ethnic Minorities Children's Program.

To represent the community, Lacham Kol was selected as a _ Project Advisory Committee (PAC) member in 2016. Since then, he has been working with honesty and dedication. I joined in

2017 and, with that, the story of stepping forward is continuing on.
