"I am so thrilled about this update that, there are more Rajoar people in Bangladesh than we realized!" One of the participants said that he was happy because he will be introduced to his community people all around Bangladesh through the research data report of SIL International Bangladesh.

A vital purpose of the research was to provide information about these (Teli, Turi, Mushohor, and Rajoar) little-known communities to the government and non-governmental organizations. Some data were enriched from participants and guests participated in the data validation workshop. One of the guests commented on the use of indigenous languages, saying, *"Our mother tongue is one of the dying languages; now we have to decide whether we will speak Bengali or our mother tongue to keep it alive?"* This comment emphasized the existence of each community's mother tongue because language is one of the most crucial components of the research work.
